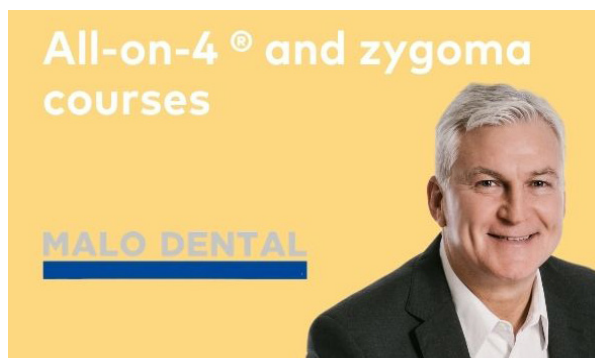

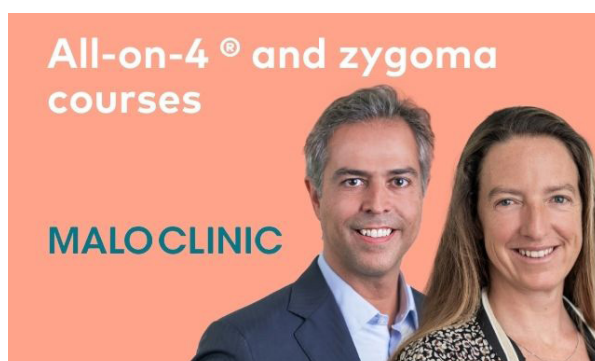

# Speakers



## **Dr. Tariq Ali**

Dr. Ali qualified from the University of Glasgow with a degree in Dental Surgery in 1998. Dr Ali then went on to train in aesthetic and implant dentistry, studying under world renowned experts and completing his training at the Royal College of Surgeons in London. He is one of a few select dentists who have passed the highly regarded Faculty of General Dental Practice Diploma in Implant Dentistry and he is now a member of the Faculty of General Dental Practice and the Association of Dental Implantology.



## **Dr. Javier Bobes Bascaran**

Dr. Javier Bobes Bascaran is a dentist with more than 15 years experience. He holds a Masters degree in Prosthesis and Occlusion and a Ph.D. in implant biomechanics. He has postgraduate qualifications and training in various disciplines such as: implantology, periodontology, orthodontics, cosmetic dentistry, restorative, facial aesthetics, sleep medicine and temporomandibular joint disorders. He takes a multidisciplinary approach to dentistry. Dr. Bobes Bascaran is published in multiple scientific journals and has

Eric graduated from the University of Naples, Italy, in 2011. After graduating, he moved to the UK he started his career in Hospitals as a Specialty doctor in Oral Surgery. He has worked as Specialty Doctor in Oral surgery at Royal Surrey County Hospital, Whipps Cross University London Hospital, Eastbourne DGH , Northampton General Hospital, Glan Clwyd Hospital (Wales). He has also gained a Masters degree diploma in Oral Implantology and Orthodontics and the title of Specialist in Oral Surgery. He currently

practices in Central London and London suburb areas as an Oral and Implant surgeon. His expertise ranges from providing simple to complex treatment such as dento-alveolar extraction, bone grafting, Implant surgery using digital computer assistance. He is also part of a specialist team focused on the fully Guided Implant Surgery and X-Guide® Dynamic surgical implant treatment.



## **Dr. Katie Blake**

Katie graduated from St Bartholomew's and The Royal London School of Medicine and Dentistry in 2010. She then worked as a General Dentist in London and a Senior House Officer in Oral Maxillofacial Facial Surgery in King's College London. # Speakers



## **Dr. Robert Bolt**

Dr. Robert Bolt is a Clinical Lecturer and registered Specialist in Oral Surgery. He is both medically and dentally qualified and is Director of the University of Sheffield's "One-to-One" dental implantology course. Dr. Bolt completed a PhD relating to the role of the microenvironment in the management of HPV-related oropharyngeal carcinoma in 2015, and continues to work in both clinical and in-vitro fields of research. Dr. Bolt's interests include dental implantology, HPV-related oropharyngeal carcinoma, 3D tissue culture modelling, pre- & peri-operative anxiety management, and bone augmentation.



## **Dr. Richard Brookshaw**

Richard first qualified in 1996 from the University of Dundee. Then in 1999, he gained his Master's degree in Oral Surgery from the University of Sheffield and further extended his clinical qualification in 2001 by completing an 18-month implant training programme. In 2009, he attained the highest honours award in the 1-year implant master program from the University of California Los Angeles/ gIDE program. In 2009, he was one of the first five implant dentists in the country to be awarded the Diploma in Implant Dentistry from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (Dip Imp Dent RCS Ed). Richard is both nationally and internationally respected as a lecturer and mentor in all aspects of Implant Dentistry. He lectures for Nobel Biocare nationally and internationally on a range of advanced implant techniques and is a regular lecturer and contributor at the Nobel Biocare international conferences. He is one of only a handful of implant surgeons nationwide who is able to carry out implant surgery in patients with extreme bone loss, using specially designed zygomatic implants. Richard exclusively practices all aspects of implant dentistry, including hard and soft tissue augmentation, sinus grafting and same-day implants.



## **Dr. Andrew Dawood**

Andrew qualified from The Royal London Hospital in 1984 and followed this with hospital appointments at Guy's Hospital, University College Hospital, The Eastman Hospital and The Hospital for Sick Children, Great Ormond Street. He went on to study for a Master's degree in Conservative Dentistry at Guy's Hospital and in 2000 was accepted on to the Specialist Register in both Prosthodontics and Periodontics. He has been placing dental implants for more than 25 years, and this has become his particular area of interest and expertise. He teaches and lectures extensively in the UK and abroad, and devotes time to Research and Development in Implant Dentistry, 3D Imaging, and 3D Manufacturing with several of his innovations patented, at times using his own designs of implants which are specially manufactured by Nobel Biocare for particularly challenging cases.



## **Andrew Forsyth**

Andrew is the owner of Atelier Dental Laboratory. For the last 14 years Andrew has dedicated his workflow to immediate load cases as well as final restorations. Andrew works nationwide for many of the leading specialists concentrating on All-on-4/ teeth in a day type of work as well as newcomers of full arch work. To date Andrew has done in excess of 3000 immediate load cases as well as many thousands of final restorations, making him one of the country's most experienced technicians in this type of work. His experience over the years has made him accomplished at many different scenarios and pitfalls during the process of surgery and conversion of the laboratory side, enabling him to provide useful solutions to every eventuality. Andrew was a finalist in the national Laboratory Awards in 2017 for full arch restorations.

# Speakers



**Dr. Wail Girgis**

Wail is a Clinical Director at Devonshire House and a Specialist Prosthodontist. He provides general dental care for a broad patient base and, as a Specialist Prosthodontist, is especially skilled in the replacement of missing teeth, the restoration of natural teeth and in complicated and simple restorations of the whole mouth. Wail trained at King's College Hospital Dental School, London and went on to complete an MSc degree in Conservative Dentistry at the Eastman Dental Hospital, London where he taught thereafter as a clinical lecturer. Wail went on to teach at the International Centre for Excellence in Dentistry on the Implant Certificate Course. He is a member of the International Team for Implantology for whom he is a clinical lecturer. Wail joined Devonshire House in 1998 and is now a Clinical Director.



**Dr. David Guy**

David qualified as a dentist from Cardiff Dental School, where he was awarded the Wystan Peach prize for Restorative Dentistry. He completed, with Distinction, his Masters Degree in Implant Dentistry at Warwick Medical School. He then completed, again with Distinction, his post-graduate Certificate in Restorative Dentistry at the Eastman Institute, University College London. He was the first person to have been awarded a Fellowship of the British Society of Oral Implantology. David was an Associate Fellow of the Clinical Institute of Education at Warwick Medical School where he taught on the MSc Implant Dentistry course prior to founding an independent implant teaching facility which subsequently became Guy's College. David has also been involved in research in stem cell technology for bone regeneration with Swansea University. Between 2010 and 2012 he pioneered a new protocol for alveolar ridge augmentation (socket grafting) using a three layer approach, which has become widely used and in a recent study demonstrated a highly impressive bone volume preservation of between 95% and 105%, far in excess of most other techniques reported in the literature to date.



**Adele Holland**

Adele began her career in dentistry in 2007 where she quickly developed a passion for the industry and joined Kissdental in 2011. She has spent many years working alongside some of the best clinicians in the UK, training and gaining knowledge in all areas and aspects of dentistry. Over the years she developed her skill set and has taken on the roles of treatment coordinator, head nurse, compliance manager and implant coordinator, expanding specifically in implantology and surgical procedures



**Dr. Robin Horton**

Dr Robin Horton is the owner of and principal dentist at Wayside Dental Practice and has been placing dental implants for over 15 years. Robin has revolutionised patient care at Wayside by investing in dental lasers (all clinicians offer diode and waterlase laser dentistry), CBCT, Intra-oral scanners, T-scan bite analysis and EMS Airflow (each hygienist has one), and of course the X-Guide. Robin has now placed over 300 implants with the X-Guide which has taken implant placement to another level of comfort, safety, precision and aesthetic outcome. Robin lectures internationally on dental lasers and implants and is also a mentor for Nobel Biocare.

**Dr Fiona J. MacKillop,**

Fiona qualified from Glasgow University in 1993. Following a short spell in general practice; she began her career in Periodontology, achieving a Masters Degree from Guy's Hospital in Periodontology in 1997. In 1998, Fiona accepted a post as Assistant Clinical Professor of Surgical Sciences (Periodontics) at New York University. She was then accepted on to the specialist register in Periodontology in 2005. Fiona continued working for a period, at Guys' Hospital as an Honorary Clinical Demonstrator in the Department of Periodontology. For the past 20 years her work has been focused in private practice. Her interests include bone regeneration and soft-tissue considerations in dental and implant sites. Having been very much involved with the British Women's Society of Implant Dentistry since 2016, Fiona is a strong advocate for women in dentistry. She was accepted onto the board of the Association of Dental Implantology in 2024, and is keen to continue promoting and encouraging more women into the field of implant dentistry.



**Dr. Scott MacLean**

Dr. Scott MacLean graduated from the Dalhousie Dental School in 1991. Dr. MacLean is the owner of Trimac Dental Centre in Halifax, where he maintains a strong focus on implant and aesthetic dentistry. An active member of the dental community, Dr. MacLean is a fellow of the International Congress of Oral Implantology, the Canadian Academy of Restorative Prosthodontics, the Academy of Dentistry International, the Pierre Fauchard Academy, the American College of Dentists, the International College of Dentists, and the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontics. **Dr. Harpreet Mandair**

Harpreet Mandair qualified in 2012 from the University of Birmingham. He achieved the University of Birmingham Conservative Dentistry 2012 award for the best restorative dentist.
